Paper assignment 2 – Employment opportunities – Job exploration

Write a 2-page paper (Approximately 1000 words)

Before you can make a career choice, you have to learn about yourself and your interests. What do you have a passion to spend your day involved in? What is it about work that is appealing to you? What's going to motivate you that will make you want to get up and contribute each day?

Step 1: define what you believe you are good at in the theatrical industry. Sometimes it helps to ask a friend or supervisor who is also familiar with your work. In a paragraph outline what those skills are.

Step 2: Start exploring 3 companies that offer roughly the same job or 3 different positions available within one company. Research companies or organizations that you might want to work in <u>OR</u> identify what role you want to do in the industry once you are out of school and search for employers that are offering positions in that area

While you are searching, make note of what positions available and extract some examples of the requirements needed to apply for the position (minimum requirements are often listed).

Step 3: Answer these questions what kinds of salaries are being offered for the select positions. (is that a livable wage?) Are they local? What materials would you have to submit to apply (resume, portfolio, etc.)?
